EM News



Australian Government
National Recovery and Resilience Agency

The Australian Government launched the National Recovery and Resilience Agency on 5 May 2021 to support local communities to respond to major disasters.

The new agency will assist communities with relief and recovery efforts following large-scale natural disasters. The Agency will also provide advice to Government on managing the impact of future disaster events.

The Agency an important step for Australia's ability to respond to natural and other disasters. There will be a focus on locally-led, locally understood and locally implemented recovery.

These efforts will ensure that recovery in affected communities can commence sooner, as well as better preparing people to respond to future disasters.



When Victoria's first SEMP was approved on 30 September 2020, the Emergency Management Commissioner agreed to review the [SEMP](#) (including its [Roles and Responsibilities](#)) in 2021 to ensure learnings from the 2020-21 summer season and any recommendations from reviews and inquiries are considered and the SEMP revised accordingly. In addition, there were a number of items that could not be resolved prior to the SEMP's initial release which have been captured on an issues register for consideration during this review.

EMV is now engaging with each agency's Emergency Management Planning Reform Inter-Departmental Committee representative and all agencies with roles and responsibilities under the SEMP to address the 337 identified issues outlined in the issues register.

Currently, 99 of the 337 issues have been marked as resolved with the remaining to be addressed in upcoming meetings or workshops before the final

revised SEMP (including Roles and Responsibilities) is provided to the State Crisis and Resilience Council (SCRC) for approval in October.
