First Attack - Fire Extinguisher & Fire Blanket (Live Fire)

1 hour

Evacuation Drills

2.5 hours

It is a requirement under AS3745-2010 to run at least 1 full evacuation exercise for your building/workplace each year.

Evacuation Drills:

- Test Emergency Management Plans & Procedures
- Ensure staff are familiar with their emergency exits and escape paths
- Ensure staff with emergency management roles are confident to perform their duties

At the conclusion of the drill, a complete debrief will be conducted with all staff involved and a report will be provided outlining potential improvements.
